# 2021 BOARD OF DIRECTOR ELECTIONS

USA Archery will hold the following Board of Director elections and appointments in 2021:

#### **USAA Board of Directors**

- 3 Athlete Directors
  - 1 Para Athlete Director
  - 2 At-Large Athlete Directors (one of which must be female)
- 1 Coach Director
- 1 Non-JOAD Club Director
- 2 additional Independent Directors will be appointed by the N&GC as well as 1 Independent Director replacing Julio Mazzoli who is terming out.
- These additions will increase the BOD size from 10 to 15 directors with 33.33% Athlete representation

Note: The initial \$337,200 PPP loan received in May 2020 and forgiven by the SBA on January 22, 2021 was recorded as revenue in 2020 following accounting principles (recorded when eligible for forgiveness). The 2021 budget was projected to have a deficit of \$127,195, however USA Archery was able to obtain a second PPP loan for \$310,369.92 in January 2021 which along with the \$1,564.60 accrued interest was forgiven on July 30, 2021.




- A new organizational strategic plan will be developed for 2022-2028 leading up to the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games in Los Angeles, CA.
