

# 2024 USA Archery JOAD Target Nationals (JTN) and JOAD U.S. Open Balloon Fiesta Park Albuquerque, NM \* July 17-21, 2024

## **COMPETITION FORMAT AND RULES**

The 2024 USA Archery JOAD Target Nationals (JTN) will follow rules and procedures from the World Archery and USAA Rules and interpretations. <u>Review rules and interpretations here</u>.

### **Rounds:**

<u>JTN Target Nationals</u>: Each archer will shoot 2 single distance rounds - 72 arrows on Thursday, 72 arrows on Friday. Guests (non-U.S. citizens) shoot in separate categories. JOAD Target Nationals will serve as the seeding for the JOAD U.S. Open and determine the National Champion. <u>JOAD U.S. Open</u>: The top 64 archers in each category will compete in head-to-head eliminations on Saturday. Guests are combined in this phase.

<u>Team Rounds</u>: Sign up for team rounds during online registration. All teams will be randomly assigned 3 archers, one each from approx. the top 1/3, middle 1/3 and bottom 1/3 of the participating archers in the category based on Thursday's qualification round, and randomly placed into brackets to determine matches.

The deadline for confirming JTN Optional team participation is the end of day on Wednesday, July 17, 2024 – or when the venue has reached capacity.

## **Eligibility:**

U.S. Citizens:

• USA Archery membership

Non-U.S. Citizen:

- USA Archery membership or Temporary Membership for Foreign Nationals.
- Non-U.S. citizens will compete in the JOAD Target Nationals rounds in the Guest category.

If an athlete is not a U.S. Citizen, they must have written permission and not have competed for the Archery Federation of the country from which they have a valid passport to compete for 1 year prior. Guests will be combined with eligible USAA members for Elimination and Team Rounds.

#### Format:

Thursday – AM 72-arrow round; PM 72-arrow round.

Friday – AM 72-arrow round; PM 72-arrow round; JOAD Target National Championship Awards Saturday – AM eliminations; PM eliminations; JOAD U.S. Open Awards Sunday – Team rounds; Team Awards

## JOAD Nationals Age Classes:

- Participants may compete as a "U13" through the calendar year of their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Participants may compete as a "U15" through the calendar year of their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Participants may compete as a "U18" through the calendar year of their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Participants may compete as a "U21" through the calendar year of their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday

#### **Competition Distances:**

U21 Male and Female Recurve – 70m; 122cm target face, 6 arrows per end, 12 ends per day U18 Male and Female Recurve - 60m; 122 cm target face, 6 arrows per end, 12 ends per day U15 Male and Female Recurve - 40m; 122cm target face, 6 arrows per end, 12 ends per day

U13 Male and Female Recurve - 30m; 122cm target face, 6 arrows per end, 12 ends per day U21 Male and Female Compound- 50m; 80cm 6-ring target face\*, 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day U18 Male and Female Compound - 50m; 80cm 6-ring target face\*, 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day U15 Male and Female Compound - 40m; 80cm 6-ring target face\*, 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day U13 Male and Female Compound - 30m; 80cm 6-ring target face\*, 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day Barebow+ U21 and U18, Male & Female – 50m; 122 cm target face; 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day Barebow+ U15 and U13, Male & Female – 30m; 122 cm target face; 6 arrow ends, 12 ends per day **Fixed Pins categories will shoot same as Compound but will score outer 10-ring.** + A "Barebow" by definition is a Recurve bow without a sight or other accessories.

\*All Compound archers will shoot on their own individual target face using the 80-centimeter multicolor 6-ring target face that score out to the 5-ring.

All participants from the JTN are automatically entered into the JOAD U.S. Open. Participation in the JTN is required to participate in the JOAD U.S. Open.

### The JOAD U.S. Open:

The JOAD U.S. Open is an Elimination Round match play event. The U.S. Open will be comprised of the combined participants (Eligible USA Archery members and Guests) from the JTN. Compound and Fixed Pins athletes will score using cumulative scoring. Recurve and Barebow athletes will score using the Set System. When applicable, there will be a cut to 64 archers per category. U.S. Open Elimination Rounds will take place at the same distances and target faces listed above for the Target National Rounds.

## **Optional Team Round:**

Archers electing to participate in the Optional Team Round will be randomly assigned to a team according to category (gender, age, bow type). Teams are then randomly seeded into elimination brackets. Team rounds should conclude between 1-3 pm on Sunday.

#### Practice:

Practice on the day of competition will be limited to 2 or 3 ends (depending on the round to be shot) prior to scoring rounds on assigned targets. There will be a separate practice area available on-site during designated hours.

## **Registration and Payment:**

Registration for the 2024 JTN will be available online. An archer will not be considered a registered participant unless the registration form, waiver and payment have been submitted. Archers should verify their registration by checking the list of participants posted on the <u>USA Archery</u> <u>website</u>.

#### Entering More Than One Class:

An archer may compete in more than one division (i.e., Compound or Recurve), but may not compete in more than one age class in another division. Separate fees and separate registration forms are required for each division in which an archer shoots.

### Scoring:

Electronic scoring will be used at this event. The paper scorecard will be the final determinant in any discrepancy between the electronic scorecard and the paper scorecard for the value of each arrow. Make sure to fill in your scorecard completely and legibly. A miss is marked on the scorecard as an "M". In outdoor competitions, the inner ten-ring is marked on the scorecard as an "X". Arrow values may not be changed once the arrow is removed from the target; however, addition may be corrected at any time before the scorecard is signed and submitted. Scorecards shall be submitted to the scoring team upon completion of the round, no later than one hour after the end of shooting. The scoring team is not obligated to correct mistakes found on a scorecard. Please be sure to check and double check scorecards before submitting!

Award ceremonies will be held according to the schedule. If you are not planning to attend, please make arrangements to have your award picked up. There will be separate awards for those competing in the Guest Class for the Qualification Rounds. Guests will be combined within their respective classes and divisions for the JOAD U.S. Open Elimination Rounds and Team Rounds. Each event will have a set of awards given from these results.
