Overview:

Club leaders may submit an application form for one, or multiple categories they feel their club and its members are excelling in.

Application Criteria:

USA Archery Youth, Adult, Both Youth and Adult Clubs, and Collegiate Programs in good membership standing may submit a nomination for these awards.

Nomination forms should be completed electronically and submitted to clubs@usarchery.org no later than **October 15, 2025.** Forms received after the deadline will not be considered.

USA Archery will review nomination forms to determine a winner from each category. USA Archery will determine the Club of Year from the nomination forms received (clubs that wish to be in the running for Club of Year should demonstrate excellence in multiple categories).

Category: Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Access
