2026 USA ARCHERY T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST

USA Archery is excited to bring you the 2026 USA Archery T-Shirt Design Contest. Put your spin on an archery inspired-USA Archery t-shirt. Compete for a USA Archery Prize Pack and the chance for your design to be sold in the USA Archery Store!

The contest will run from March 23 - April 22, with the design finalists being voted on by the public April 30 - May 7. See Official Rules for all exclusions, restrictions, submission guidelines and other details regarding this contest.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to submit an entry, you need to be a USA Archery member between the age of 8 and 22. If you are less than 18 years of age, your submission must be made by your parent or legal guardian.

PRIZES

We have some exciting prizes in store for the winners. See the Official Rules for details and restrictions regarding all prizes in this contest. Contest prizes include:

WINNER

The grand prize winner will receive three (3) printed t-shirts bearing the grand prize winning design, a USA Archery jersey and a pack of Series 1 2025 - 2026 World Archery Trading Cards. The winning design will be sold on-site at JOAD Target Nationals, as well as on USA Archery's official online store.

RUNNER-UP

The runner-up will receive one (1) printed t-shirt bearing the design submitted by the first runner-up, a USA Archery water bottle, and a USA Archery sticker. The runner-up design will be sold on USA Archery's official online store.

DESIGN OVERVIEW AND GUIDELINES

Artists and archers put your own spin on an archery design. We challenge you to create an original t-shirt design inspired by target archery, competition and USA Archery.

We look forward to receiving your submissions for the contest. Guidelines for design submissions:

- Archery themed
 - Competitive or recreational archery only
 - If using a target as a design element, target must be standard World Archery target face, or World Archery field or 3D targets
 - Designers may use:
 - » USA Archery logo within guidelines (discussed below)
 - » USA Archery brand colors
 - » Positive portrayal of sport/archery
 - Designers must use:
 - » Your creative minds 😊
 - Designers cannot use:
 - » Olympic or Paralympic rings or logos
 - » Profanity or demeaning language/images
 - » Negative portrayal of athletes or teams
 - » Adult content (alcohol, drugs, swearing, etc.)
 - » Copyrighted material of third parties
- Designs will be for the front of t-shirts only with a design space of between 6" wide x 14" long and 12" wide by 18" long.
 - Invalid/Rejected Designs
 - Some common reasons designs may be rejected from entering the contest:*
 - » Violations of trademark/copyright
 - » Inappropriate language/degrading/negative speech
 - » Incorrect use of USA Archery logo
 - » Poor use of text

Any submissions received with any of the above 'cannot use' criteria will be rejected.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR DESIGN

Read

Visit

Create

- Your design can be created using whatever method you wish as long as it can be saved on a computer in high resolution, i.e. you can hand draw it, scan it and upload as a high resolution .jpeg file
- If you draw your design digitally, please make sure it's saved in high resolution
- If your design is drawn by hand, please do not send a photograph of it, the drawing will need to be scanned

Save

- Images should be saved as a high resolution raster (.jpg, .png, .bmp, .psd) or vector based (.eps, .ai) image
 - If submitting a vector based image, all text must be flattened
- Save as a .eps, .ai, .psd, .bmp, .gif or .png file

Upload

Click the "Submit Your Design" button on the contest landing page.

Promote

USA Archery staff will select 6 designs that will then be up for a public vote to determine the winner and runner-up. USA Archery will contact you if your design is selected as a finalist. If it is accepted, promote it! Use social media to generate visibility and interest in your design. Invite family and friends to vote and generate excitement around your design.

- Original and clear concept
- Positive representation of archery
- No inappropriate language/degrading/negative speech
- No third-party trademarks/copyrights
- Correct file submission

NO ENTRY FEE/ELIGIBILITY

There is no entry fee or membership required to submit a design. Please see Official Rules for eligibility. Void outside the United States and where prohibited by law.

AFFILIATIONS

This contest is not affiliated with Facebook or Instagram.

NOTIFICATIONS

The last day to submit a design is April 22, 2026. Notifications will be sent to those who are selected to move on to the voting round and to the eventual winners. Winners will be announced the week of May 25, 2026.


FINAL DECISION

The winning design will have the USA Archery logo placed in a corner of the design, if not already present



COMMON LOGO MISUSE

Never use colors outside the official palette. Never reverse or rotate official colors.

Never skew the logo, or modify its proportions.

Never dissect the logo or use its individual components.

Never add graphic components (e.g.) outlines/strokes or unapproved typography.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR CONTRIBUTION TO USA Archery WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to USA Archery members between the ages of 8 and 22 who submit a design via survey link, available [here](#). In order to submit an entry, you need to be a USA Archery member between the age of 8 and 22. If you are less than 18 years of age, your submission must be made by your parent or legal guardian.

Employees of USA Archery, Employees of Sponsor, and other companies associated with the promotion of the Contest, its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and suppliers, and immediate family members (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and/or those living in the same household of Employees are not eligible to participate in the Contest. The Contest is subject to all federal, state, local, municipal laws and regulations.

CONTEST PERIOD – START AND END DATE

Entries will be accepted online starting on March 23 at 8am MT and ending April 22 11:59pm MT. Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified.

ENTRY RULES

The contest must be entered by submitting a design via survey link, which is available [here](#). Designs must be attached using any of these file formats: jpeg, png or PDF. The design must meet all Contest requirements to be eligible to win a prize. Incomplete entries or the ones which are not in alignment with the rules, requirements, and specifications will be disqualified by USA Archery. You may enter the Contest only once and you need to provide any information that might be necessary. Any attempt of circumvention of the rules will result in immediate disqualification from the Contest.

ORIGINAL CONTENT; OWNERSHIP

By participating in the Contest, each Participant guarantees that they are the exclusive owner of the copyright and all other proprietary rights in any and all materials and content submitted by the Participant to enter the Contest, except for use of the USA Archery logo, if any, which shall at all times remain the property of USA Archery. Guidelines for use of the USA Archery logo are set forth in Contest Guidelines. The Participant further claims and guarantees that they have the right to grant to any third party the right to use, reproduce, distribute, perform and display any design file. All entries must have appropriate clearances, permissions and releases PRIOR to submitting, or may be eliminated from the Contest. Any unauthorized samples or performances of another artist’s material could be subject to fines, royalty fees, and/or legal action for which the Participant agrees to indemnify, defend and hold USA Archery harmless. USA Archery may use any t-shirt design file on-demand on USA Archery’s or its affiliates’ websites.

RIGHTS GRANTED BY CONTEST PARTICIPANTS

By entering this Contest and sending your design the Participant understands and agrees that USA Archery and/or anyone acting on behalf of USA Archery has the right, where permitted by law, to use the submission and non-identifiable personal information for purposes of promoting this Contest without limitation and without any further compensation, notice, review, or consent.

DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY

USA Archery is not responsible for problems with Contest entries, including but not limited to, entries which are lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, illegible, or cannot be completed due to electronic or technical difficulties, even if the problem is the result of the sole or partial negligence of USA Archery.

PRIZES

Winner of the Contest (the "Winner") will receive a USA Archery Prize Pack. The grand prize winner will receive three (3) printed t-shirts bearing the grand prize winning design, a USA Archery Jersey, and a pack of Series 1 2025 – 2026 World Archery Trading Cards. The runner-up will receive one (1) printed t-shirt bearing the design submitted by the runner-up, a USA Archery Water Bottle and a USA Archery sticker.

Prizes cannot be redeemed for cash or substituted for another prize, and is non-transferable. Prize-related expenses including all federal, state, and local taxes represent the sole financial responsibility of the Winner. The prize is given with no written, express, or implied warranty. Any prize not claimed within 30 days will be forfeited by the winner and remain the property of USA Archery.

WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

Winner will be selected by USA Archery members and social media followers votes under the supervision of USA Archery. Winner will be informed about the prize by email and phone call within 3 days following the Winner selection to claim the prize. USA Archery is not responsible if the Winner fails to receive the notice about the prize due to any security settings or provision of incorrect contact information. If the Winner fails to respond within the required time period, the prize may be forfeited, and an alternate Winner may be selected based on votes. If the Winner is considered a minor in their place of residence, USA Archery reserves the right to place the prize in the name of the Winner's parent or legal guardian who will be requested to sign the Declaration of Claim on the Winner's behalf. Acceptance of the prize given in this Contest is in accordance with any and all federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
