RANGE PASS?



A **Range Pass** is required for any club employee, club officer, volunteer, instructor, coach, judge, administrator, athlete or member who is formally authorized or appointed to a position of authority over, or will have frequent contact with minor athletes within a USA Archery event or club activity.

To add a Range Pass to your profile, scan the QR Code, select **View Profile, Training History**, and click **Add Training History**.

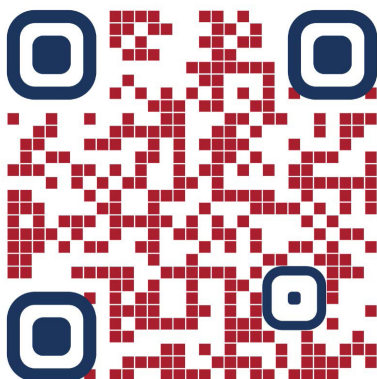

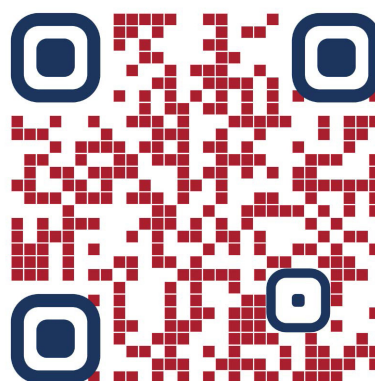
**REPORTS OF EMOTIONAL MISCONDUCT, PHYSICAL MISCONDUCT, OR VIOLATIONS OF THE
