

STATE ASSOCIATION FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROGRAM





PURPOSE

The State Association Financial Support Program is designed to strengthen and expand opportunities for USA Archery members by providing strategic funding to State Associations. The funding provided empowers states to plan proactively, align with USA Archery's **strategic plans**, and invest in initiatives that best serve USA Archery members and clubs. Funding may be applied toward event development, operations and/or sport development, offering flexibility to meet each state's unique needs.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for funding State Associations must:

- Have a current USA Archery State Association membership
- Have submitted the current year annual State Association compliance paperwork by the stated deadline and be in good standing.
 - Per section 1.5 in the USA Archery State Association Terms and Conditions, State Associations who do not renew their membership, are in a probationary status or fail to submit complete and accurate annual compliance paperwork by the required deadline and/or are not in good standing at the time of the grant application deadline will not be eligible for the grant program.

BASE FUNDING

Base funding may be used to support State Associations operations, events and/ or sport development initiatives. States are encouraged to review the state member dashboard and identify strategic initiatives to retain and grow their member base by providing exceptional customer service, high quality events and other member support. Should additional funds be necessary to accomplish the State Associations growth initiatives, they may also apply for a Grant.

USAA will calculate the state association's annual Base Funding by using approximately half of the state's historical membership rebate value for the 12 calendar months prior to the application deadline.

2026 EXCEPTION

For 2026, State Associations with a membership expiring in 2026 will continue to receive quarterly rebates in accordance with the 2025 State Association Member Terms and Conditions. As a result, not all State Associations will be eligible for "Base Funding" in 2026. Base funding allocation amounts will be reviewed annually.

2026 BASE FUNDING ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- States receiving Q1 2026 Rebates: Eligible for 50% of Base Funding
- States receiving Q1 and Q2 2026 Rebates: Will not receive Base Funding
- States receiving Q1, Q2 and Q3 2026 Rebates: Will not receive Base Funding
- State Associations who are not scheduled to receive rebates in 2026 will be eligible for 100% of their Base Funding

BASE FUNDING APPLICATION PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Prior to completing the Base Funding online application process, please review your state's membership dashboard and member heatmap provided by USA Archery to aid in your state's strategic planning process.

MEMBERSHIP GROWTH FINANCIAL INCENTIVE

Beginning in 2027, USAA will provide additional financial awards to State Associations for membership growth within the prior 12 month period (i.e. state dashboard growth):

- Individual Paid Membership (Youth, Collegiate, Adult and/or Family):
 - ▶ \$1,000 for growing 100 or more individual paid members on the State Association dashboard over prior year member dashboard number
- Club Paid Membership (Youth, Adult, Both and/or Collegiate):
 - ▶ \$225 for growing 5 or more clubs on State Association dashboard over prior year club dashboard number.

STATE ASSOCIATION GRANT PROGRAM

Eligible State Associations may apply for a grant in the following categories:

Event Development: The event development grant will support State Associations to improve the quality of events, grow event participation, increase event capacity and/or invest in equipment.

Operations: The operations grant will support State Associations to improve operational efficiency, financial management, marketing and communications and/or good governance.

Sport Development: The sport development grant will assist State Associations to support instructor, club or judge growth, increase member retention and participation and/or provide support to USA Archery members and/or clubs.

GRANT REPORTING AND COMPLIANCE

The following will be required annually by September 10th:

I. State Association Grant Report Form (If Applicable)

- Grant recipients will be required to report on the grant expenditures and/ or planned expenditures to include how the funds were used, the impact the funding had on achieving stated goals and the total amount spent.
- ► Failure to spend the grant dollars for the purpose(s) requested without a USA Archery pre-approved reallocation plan may impact an organization's ability to apply for future grant dollars and/or repayment of the grant.
