- Current [Mental Management 101](#) certificate (applicants need to pay for, and complete this online course prior to the certification course)

2021 Level 4NTS Course Grant Information

- USA Archery Level 4NTS Course
- Current Level 3NTS USA Archery Instructor/ Coach or higher
- This course is scheduled for late Fall 2021. Currently it is being planned in person, but if necessary, the course will be virtual.
- Lead Instructor: Guy Krueger, USA Archery Education and Training Manager, Level 5NTS Coach

Applicant Requirements:

- Minimum Age is 19
- A certain number of coaches who attend the Virtual Level 3-NTS Coach course as well as a number of existing Level 3-NTS Collegiate Coaches will be chosen from the applicant pool
 - An exception to the standard requirements to attend the Level 4-NTS course will be made for individuals selected from the Virtual Level 3-NTS course. [All other applicants will be expected to meet Level 4-NTS course requirements.](#)
- Current USA Archery Membership, Background Screen, Center for SafeSport Training
- Current [Mental Management 102](#) certificate (applicants need to pay for, and complete this online course prior to the certification course)

Grant Overview:

- USA Archery will notify applicants if their application was accepted/denied
- Grant will cover registration if the course is virtual and will cover registration and a stipend to cover expenses if it is in person.
 - Upon successful completion of the Level 4NTS course and certification requirements, USA Archery will send individuals a check for up to \$850 to cover costs related to flights, transportation, lodging and food*.
 - *If courses are able to be held in person, there will be one course in Chula Vista, CA and a Midwest/East Coast location as well. The registration fee for the Chula Vista course includes meals and housing so checks sent to applicants attending the Chula Vista course will be up to \$500 and checks sent to applicants attending the Midwest/East Coast course will be up to \$850
- USA Archery will register all grant recipients directly and the grant will cover the registration fee directly. USA Archery will send follow up information to ask coaches which course they prefer to attend if courses are able to be hosted in-person
