If an athlete is not a U.S. Citizen, but living in the U.S. and wants to compete for a national title and USAT ranking points, they must have the written permission, and no longer be competing for, the Member Association of the country from which they have a valid passport to compete.

Non-U.S. citizens will compete in the GUEST division of the during the qualification rounds and will be combined with eligible USAA members in elimination and team rounds.

Coaching Credentials for Practice, Qualification and Elimination Rounds:

USA Archery credentialed coaches are allowed access to the Coach Area only.

Coach credentials will be available for purchase on the USA Archery website ONLY. There will be no on-site sales. Price is \$50 for the duration of the event. Non-credentialed coaches shall remain in open spectator areas outside of the field of play.

Requirements for Coach Credentials: USAA members must also have current Level 2 Coach/Instructor certification or higher, SafeSport certificate and clear Background screen.

Agents for Archers with Disabilities:

If an archer needs an agent to assist with duties at the target or elsewhere, the archer should plan to bring the agent with them to the event. If they do not have an agent, they may contact the organizer of the event to see if they have an agent available, but the responsibility of having an agent lies with the archer. Credentialed persons assisting archers with disabilities or the tournament officials may sit within the archers' area.
