We trust that by now everyone appreciates that these measures are for everyone's health and safety which is our primary concern.

**HEALTH & SAFETY COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES UPON ARRIVAL:** All drivers and passengers in all vehicles arriving at the event will have their temperature taken by a non-contact thermometer to confirm that no one has a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher. **Vehicles and their occupants will be denied entry if they refuse to have their temperature taken, or any occupants confirm that they have been in contact with anyone who is experiencing any acute respiratory illness symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, or confirmed positive in the last 14 days for COVID-19.**

**EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR PERSONAL COMPLIANCE:**

**WHILE PRACTICING AND COMPETING ON THE RANGES:**

1. Masks will be worn at all time except while shooting.
2. Social distancing should be observed while shooting and practicing.
3. Direct physical contact should be avoided at all times.
4. Everyone is requested to bring their own water bottles. Bottled water will be available on the ranges, but may not be on ice.
5. Archery equipment should only be touched by the shooter themselves.
6. When pulling arrows each archer should pull their own, or an arrow-puller should be used.
7. **Masks are required for all coaches and spectators on the ranges.**
8. **Spectators may be limited on ranges to maintain social distancing.**

**COMMON AREA PRACTICES:**

1. Masks are to be worn at all times except when eating.
2. Social distancing will be observed.
3. Large purely social gatherings are prohibited.
4. Common area chairs and tables will be limited and will not be moved to comply with prevailing Best Practices Guidelines.
5. Food services that are offered will comply with prevailing state and/or local guidelines, and six-foot distancing will be required while in line.
