

USA Archery - Record Claim Form



To submit a claim for a World or National record, please follow these steps:

- National Record: Submit Record Claim no later than **10 days** after the tournament.
- World Record: Submit Record Claim no later than **5 days** after the tournament and **with a copy of the official event results or link**.
- Email completed claim documents to: records@usarchery.org
- Include a clear photocopy of the score card(s) signed by both the competitor and the Judge or DOS or COJ.
- **ARCHERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCURACY OF SCORECARD!**
- Be sure to complete all applicable fields in the Claim Form.
- Use multiple forms if more than 5 records claimed.
- Check your claim against current records posted here: <http://www.teamusa.org/USAArchery/Events/Records>
- By signing you declare that the event was registered with USA Archery, conducted under World Archery rules, and that all the information you provide is accurate.
- Claims for World (but NOT "National") records can only be made at events registered with USA Archery and World Archery.
