

USA Archery Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Access Coach Education Grant

USA Archery is now accepting applications for the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Access Coach Education Grant. USA Archery is committed to providing coach education opportunities to individuals who represent diverse communities to advance diversity and inclusivity in the sport. Consideration will be given to individuals who belong to an underrepresented community to include women, people of color, and individuals with a physical disability and/or based on financial need.

Individuals may apply for one or more of the following grants:

2023 USA Archery Virtual Level 4 Course Grant Information

- Fall of 2023 (specific dates TBD)
- Lead Instructor: Guy Krueger, USA Archery Education and Training Manager, Level 5 Coach

Applicant Requirements:

- Must be 20 years of age or older by November 1, 2023
- Must be a current Level 3 USA Archery Coach by May 1, 2023
- Current USA Archery Membership, Background Screen and U.S. Center for SafeSport Training

Grant Overview:

Grant will provide for reimbursement of the course registration fee

The Level 4 course will be held over 6-7 weeks through Zoom and the online USA Archery Education Hub. The course will consist of:

- 9 live sessions that will be approximately 2.5 hours in duration
- 1-hour breakout sessions two times per week. Breakout sessions will be scheduled the same day or the day after the live sessions and at varying times.
- Homework assignments will be assigned including online work
- Online Final Exam
- Practical Exam (divided into 2 parts)
- Live sessions will be recorded if participants miss or want to review a session

Live sessions will feature lecture, Q&A, breakout sessions and practical exercises. USA Archery expects to maintain a 1:5 coach trainer to student ratio for breakout sessions. Coach Trainers helping with the course will have an

additional 1-2 hours available each week for "office hours." Prior to each session, students will need to complete pre-session assignments and post session homework assignments.

2023 USA Archery Coach Workshop Session 1.0 and/or Session 2.0

- Dates: Session 1.0 August 19-20, 2023, Session 2.0 August 21, 2023
- Location: Colorado Springs, CO
- Lead Instructor: Guy Krueger, USA Archery Education and Training Manager, Level 5 Coach
- This workshop will be unique from the Virtual Symposium in that it will focus
 entirely on developing coaches' skills through deliberate practice, role play, and
 feedback. The goal of this workshop is that each coach will leave the workshop
 as a better coach than when they arrived. Practice and participation will be a
 critical element of this workshop and USA Archery will provide a safe place for
 coaches to learn and grow.

The workshop will focus on developing many of the skills discussed in the Virtual Symposium the following skills:

- Providing different types of feedback and coaching
- Technical Analysis
- Cueing
- Planning Training
- Designing fun, challenging, and engaging training activities
- o Creating a community of practice for coaches

Applicant Requirements:

- Current USA Archery Level 3 Coach or higher
- Current USA Archery Membership, Background Screen and U.S. Center for SafeSport Training

- Grants up to \$800 will be provided to cover travel and registration costs:
 - Upon successful completion of the Coach's Workshop, USA Archery will reimburse individuals for approved costs related to registration, flights, transportation, lodging and food. Travel expense receipts will be required to receive reimbursement.

- Current USA Archery Level 4 Coach or higher certification
- Current USA Archery Level 3 Coach Trainer Certification
- Current USA Archery Membership, Background Screen and U.S. Center for SafeSport Training

- Grants up to \$600 will be provided to cover travel costs:
 - Upon successful completion of the Train the Trainer Workshop, USA Archery will reimburse individuals for approved costs related to flights, transportation, lodging and food. Travel receipts will be required to receive reimbursement.
