



## **2024 USA Archery Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Access Coach Education Grant**

USA Archery is now accepting applications for the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Access Coach Education Grant. USA Archery is committed to providing coach education opportunities to individuals who represent diverse communities to advance diversity and inclusivity in the sport. Consideration will be given to individuals who belong to an underrepresented community to include women, people of color, and individuals with a physical disability and/or based on financial need.

Individuals may apply for one or more of the following grants:

### **2024 USA Archery Virtual Level 4 Course Grant Information**

- Fall of 2024 (specific dates TBA)
- Lead Instructor: Guy Krueger, Director of Education, Level 5 Coach

#### **Applicant Requirements:**

- Must be 20 years of age or older by November 1, 2024
- Must be a current Level 3 USA Archery Coach by May 1, 2024
- Current USA Archery Membership, Background Screen and U.S. Center for SafeSport Training

#### **Grant Overview:**

- USA Archery will enroll recipients in the course directly

The Level 4 course will be held over 6-7 weeks through Zoom and the online USA Archery Education Hub. The course will consist of:

- 9 live sessions that will be approximately 2.5 hours in duration
- 1-hour breakout sessions two times per week. Breakout sessions will be scheduled the same day or the day after the live sessions and at varying times.
- Homework assignments will be assigned including online work
- Online Final Exam
- Practical Exam
- Live sessions will be recorded if participants miss or want to review a session

Live sessions will feature lecture, Q&A, breakout sessions and practical exercises. USA Archery expects to maintain a 1:5 coach trainer to student ratio

for breakout sessions. Coach Trainers helping with the course will have an additional 1-2 hours available each week for “office hours.” Prior to each session, students will need to complete pre-session assignments and post session homework assignments.
