



USA Archery Explore Archery Grant Application

This grant program is designed to assist local parks and recreation departments to implement the Explore Archery Program. Selected applicants will be required to send one full-time employee to attend a one-day training, where, upon completion, they will be certified as USA Archery Level 2 Instructor; and in return their department will receive the Explore Archery Program guide and achievement awards, range posters and the equipment necessary to implement a beginner to intermediate archery program.

The training will take place at The Hawk-Farmington Hills Community Center (29995 West 12 Mile Road, Farmington Hills, MI 48334) on December 7, 2021 from 8:30am-5:00pm. Applicants will be responsible for their travel expenses, however, lunch will be provided on December 7th.

Prior to the training, applicants will be required to complete the Online USA Archery Level 2 Instructor Certification Course (Approximate Time Required: 4 Hours). The \$50 cost to complete this course will be covered by the grant. Attendees will need to purchase and complete the following items prior to registering for the online course:

- USA Archery Membership: \$65 (Good for one year)
- USA Archery Background Screen: \$35 (Good for two years)
- U.S Center for SafeSport Training: Free online training

It is USA Archery's expectation that any community receiving these grant funds commits to implementing a USA Archery Explore Archery Program for a minimum of five years beginning in 2022.
