The Para Athletes Advisory Council is responsible for broadening communication between the USA Archery and active athletes and serve as a source of input and advice to the USA Archery board of directors. The Para AAC Military and Compound positions will be elected to serve a term of 4 years and the Recurve positions will be elected for a term of 2 years to implement the staggering of terms.

Compound representatives elected to the Para Athletes' Advisory Council will be eligible to run for the position of Compound Representative to the USA Archery Board of Directors in 2019. The Compound Representative to the Board of Directors shall be directly elected by Compound Athletes who meet the "Eligible Athlete" or "Para Eligible Athlete" requirements by majority vote to serve a term of 4 years

A minimum of one female and one male athlete will be elected to serve the above positions.

- Recurve (2 positions available-minimum one female will be elected)

Nominees must have:

- (i) Represented the U.S. as an athlete at the Paralympics, Para Pan American Games, Para World Championships, or other major international competitions designated as USOC Operation Gold competitions within the ten-year period prior to December 31, 2018

or

- (ii) Finished in the top half of the Para Senior division at USA Archery's 133rd or 134th U.S. National Target Championships (2017 or 2018).
