



## USA Archery Virtual Tournament

### Rules and Procedures

#### **Tournament Rules:**

All archers participating in the Virtual Tournament series must be a member of a JOAD, Collegiate or Adult Archery Program Club and have a current USA Archery membership. Temporary memberships are excluded.

1. The Club will conduct a single Virtual Tournament event. The Club leader will be responsible for submitting official scores at the conclusion of the designated event or;
2. An archer may participate in a non-virtual tournament event with an identical round. The event must take place during the same quarter as the Virtual Tournament for which the scores will be submitted, and follow the same indoor or outdoor Virtual Tournament procedures. The Club leader will be responsible for submitting official scores at the conclusion of the event.

**Please Note: Club leaders should not permit archers to shoot multiple scores for the Virtual Tournament. USA Archery reserves the right to disqualify a Club if the Virtual Tournament Rules are not followed.**

#### **Indoor Virtual Tournament Procedures (1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter):**

1. Archers shall score an official Virtual Tournament indoor round - 30 arrows (10 ends - 3 arrows each) on the appropriate target face at the appropriate distance.
2. Three archers will double score the round with a leader present.
3. Tie Breakers: Ties are determined by 10's and then if still tied, 9's (Note: Hits or "X's" do not apply).

### **Outdoor Virtual Tournament Procedures (2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter):**

1. Archers shall score an official Virtual Tournament outdoor distance round - 36 arrows (6 ends - 6 arrows each or 12 ends - 3 arrows each).
2. Three archers will double score the round with a leader present.
3. Tie Breakers: Ties are determined by 10's and then if still tied, X's.

### **Team Round Procedures:**

1. Up to three archers may form an all female and/or all male USA Archery Club team comprised of multiple classes (ages) for each division (bow type): Recurve, Basic Compound, Barebow, and Compound. Teams comprised of mixed gender and/or mixed bow types are not permitted.
2. USA Archery Clubs may enter multiple teams in each division using an archer only once per division.
3. For the team round, archers will use their score from their individual round. All team members must be a member of the reporting Club.

### **Awards:**

Results will be posted online after the conclusion of each quarter and certificates will be provided to the first, second and third place winners (individual and teams) for each division.

### **Fees:**

The fee for the tournament is \$10.00 per archer per division and \$15 per team. An archer may enter more than one division (Fees are \$10 per division entered). Scores will not be posted until payment has been processed.

### **USA Archery Tournament Classes:**

USA Archery Tournament Classes	
Master	Athlete may compete as a Master starting in the year of their 50th birthday.
Senior	Athletes in the year of their 21st birthday, and older, will compete in the Senior class.
Junior	Athletes may compete in the Junior class up to and through the year of their 20th birthday.
Cadet	Athletes may compete in the Cadet class up to and through the year of their 17th birthday.
Cub	Athletes may compete in the Cub class up to and through the year of their 14th birthday.
Bowman	Athletes may compete in the Bowman class up to and through the year of their 12th birthday.
Yeoman	This class is for youths up to and through the year of their 9th birthday.
